CONSTITUTIONAL AMMENDMENT
Article XIII

Hall of Fame

Guidelines for the Illinois High School Gymnastics Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

E. Hall of Fame Committee:

1. The committee will be composed of six members to serve a term of three years.
2. A chairman will be selected within the committee by a simple majority vote.
3. The committee will review all current nominees.
4. A majority vote by the committee is needed to approve nominees from the membership.
5. A 2/3 vote by the committee is needed to reject any nominee from the membership.
6. In February the Hall of Fame committee will meet to review names for the current year's ballot.
7. The committee will present nominees to the Association at the March meeting.
8. A 65% majority of Full Association members plus Hall of Fame members is necessary for induction into the Hall of Fame.
9. The number of inductees shall be of a number not to exceed three in any year.
10. Announcements of inductees will be made in conjunction with our annual banquet at the May meeting.
