# CONSTITUTIONAL AMMENDMENT

Article XIII

#### Hall of Fame

Guidelines for the Illinois High School Gymnastics Coaches Association Hall of Fame.

#### E. Hall of Fame Committee:

- 1. The committee will be composed of six members to serve a term of three years.
- 2. A chairman will be selected within the committee by a simple majority vote.
- 3. The committee will review all current nominees.
- 4. A majority vote by the committee is needed to approve nominees from the membership.
- 5. A 2/3 vote by the committee is needed to reject any nominee from the membership.
- 6. In February the Hall of Fame committee will meet to review names for the current year's ballot.
- 7. The committee will present nominees to the Association at the March meeting.
- 8. A 65% majority of Full Association members plus Hall of Fame members is necessary for induction into the Hall of Fame.
- 9. The number of inductees shall be of a number not to exceed three in any year.
- 10. Announcements of inductees will be made in conjunction with our annual banquet at the May meeting.
