### **Article X.C. Illinois High School Gymnastics Coaches Association Professional Attire for All IHSA Gymnastics Meets (5 years – 2012-2016)**

- a. Shoes: Closed toed shoes, no flip flops, sandals, clogs or open toe shoes.
- b. Slacks or Warm Up Pants: no shorts, jeans, denim pants.
- c. Shirt: Preferred dress or casual collared shirt, no "T" shirts unless part of the team uniform.
- d. No hats or headwear.

All state coaches will receive 4 passes for individual as well as the team competition.

If possible, please have an assistant coach round up the athletes and get them to the gym just prior to 9:15.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual John Brinkworth Senior All-Star Meet is a special competition that wraps up our season with a conference vs. conference showdown featuring the top seniors from each conference in the state. Last year's champs – the DuPage Valley Conference Senior All-Stars – posted a 167.15 team score! The meet also includes handstand and standing back competitions!

This meet was created by the Illinois High School Gymnastics Coaches Association as a fun way to celebrate our senior gymnasts' hard work and dedication.

### **Qualification**

Each conference's Senior All-Star team will be determined by the results of the Conference Meet. The top five seniors on each event from each conference will represent their conference at the Senior All-Star Meet. Large conferences will field a Senior All-Star team for each division (e.g. the MSL East vs. the MSL West).

The John Brinkworth Senior All-Star Meet will take place the Saturday *after* the State

Meet. The meet begins at 11am so that it will not conflict with proms that may be scheduled that evening.
