These suggestions will be reviewed by the Steering Committee and passed on to the Rules Committee for a recommendation as to what scenario of rules would suit under level competitions in the IHSA. This recommendation, as reviewed and approved by the Steering Committee, would be suggested to the IHSA through the approved interpretation process as under level rules for the 2014 competition season.

From Blaise:

- IHSA Officials' ratings will stay the same after the JO rule change.
- IHSA Judge certification will remain the same—all through the existing IHSA system. <u>IHSA judges will</u> not have to be JO certified.
- We have lost 9 registered officials since the 2012 season.
- Blaise encourages coaches to become judges.
