Rules Proposal Voting

Proposal 1:

Abolish the April 1st limitation for the rules committee to make interpretations

Pro: Clarifications are needed late in the season more than ever - Mukai

Con: Gymnasts and coaches late in the season may feel taken advantage by an interpretation -

Donaldson

Voting Results: Passed

Proposal 2:

The Rules Committee interpretations shall be delivered to the Secretary and to the judges' assignment chairs. The Secretary shall immediately distribute the interpretations to all association members and the judges' assignment chairs shall immediately distribute to all judges. The interpretations shall then become effective immediately.

Pro: The goal is clarity. Before any interp is delivered we live in a state of unknown, it is better to get that definition enacted immediately - Mukai

Con: Judge doesn't check their email - Gebhardt

Voting Results: Passed

Proposal 3:

Option 1:

- o A gymnast must perform a FIG "A" skill to qualify for a 1.5 minimum score.
- o A gymnast must perform a non-diagrammed "A" skill to qualify for a 1.0 minimum score.

Option 2:

o A gymnast must perform a FIG "A" or non-diagrammed "A" skill to qualify for a 1.0 minimum score.

Option 3:

o No change. (A gymnast must perform a FIG "A" skill to qualify for a 1.0 minimum score.)

- *Modification new rule is 1.0 for any HS routine*
- Scratched from ballot

Pro: Making a requirement for 1.0 min score little more separation between beginning gymnasts and others

Con: Not an

Proposal 4:

Adopt updated FIG code updates after 1 year

The IHSGCA will review and update the High School code such that it will take effect one year following the effective date of an update FIG Code. Example: The High School code written for the 2021-2024 FIG CoP will have effective dates of 2022-2025.

Pro: More time to get rule book in order, for coaches to digest the rules before they go into effect - Jaros

Con: Club kids less enthusiastic to come in that year because rules are more out of sync with FIG and club rules – Harima

Voting Results: Did not Pass

Proposal 5:

Allow a video review to accompany an inquiry

Eliminate Chapter 2, Section I.G which prevents video review

Modify Chapter 2, Section I.J.c:

c. The inquiry shall be given to the meet director/meet referee, who will give all legal inquiries to the event judges for review. The judges may consult with the meet referee.

Add Chapter 2, Section I.J.g:

g. A video of the routine in question from the current meet may be supplied to the meet director/meet referee with the inquiry. The video will be used by the judge(s) only to evaluate the claim contained in the inquiry. The video may not be used to modify deductions or take away value of any skill, bonus or element group previously granted by the judge(s).

Pro: Everyone makes mistakes, keeps judges honest and accountable - Harima Con: IHSA bylaw states that judges rules are final, low chance of actually being adopted -Blasko

Voting Results: Did not Pass

Resolution:

Notification of changes to the list of Non-Diagrammed "A" Skills by the Rules Committee will be shared with the association through email before the changes go into effect. This includes the addition and the deletion of recognized Non-Diagrammed "A" Skills. Deleted items will be crossed out in the document and will be displayed for the rest of the season to make it clear what is no longer being recognized.
