Clarification on Rules:

- Make sure you have the up to date rules interps, non-diagramed A's list, Fig Code of points and the policies & procedures book. Make sure you are familiar with all of these documents.
- *Latest updates:*
 - List of A skills was updated (half higgins removed b/c already a FIG A)
 - On rings, if a swing to strength is too high for credit (ex. back uprise cross), you can still give credit for both parts separately (ex. the back uprise, and the cross)
 - Peach to support can be repeated for credit

Fundraising
