- Please make the sacrifice to leave your gym early and take a few judging assignments.
- Encourage your assistant coaches to register to judge and take judging assignments.
- Ryan -- Taking judging assignments is hard because you have to sacrifice time in the gym to do so.
- Blaise -- Maybe start meets at 7:00 to alleviate the pressure of taking time out of practices to go judge
- Bill -- Is there a possibility of enticing semi-retired NCAA judges to come out and judge high school? If we move gymnastics to a fall sport, that may help
- Keith -- Planning to start a new freshman meet next year. This may be a good opportunity to break in new judges and improve their confidence
- Bill -- Is there a way to allow coaches to attend meetings remotely, either by skype or other digital means?

- Paul -- Can we sell the shirts at cost? It's already hard enough to sell shirts for \$10, and we're already pulling enough money out of the kids for meet tickets and transportation.
 - Brandon is doing extra fundraisers to pay for the shirts, etc.
 - Steering committee talked about it at the last meeting, and decided to go with \$10.
- Brandon -- Kids can also reuse the shirts for conference and sectionals.
- Keith -- Can the association credit back the potential association profit on shirts for schools who ask for it?
- Frank -- Motion: If the cost of the shirt is less than \$10, any coach that asks for credit back for the association profits from their portion of the order will be paid back.

- Brandon -- Spread the word about the shirts.
- Eric H -- Please consider volunteering to deliver shirts for coaches that live or coach near you to entice them to make an order.

 - We may be overlooking coach recruiting as we emphasize judge recruiting. Do people have any ideas?
 - Bill -- Has a volunteer coach who is interested, helped to pay for AESP certification
 - Brandon -- Help spread the word how easy the ASEP certification is

- Alex -- Try to recruit at club gyms. That's how Frank recruited him
- Ryan -- Has 5 former gymnasts who are working at club gyms during college. He can see if they want to move into HS
- Frank IHSA Advisory Board meeting in 2 weeks. If you want to bring anything up please let Frank know.
 - Doug -- Can we get 10 medals at state for finals?
 - Blaise -- Was anybody here on the advisory board in the last couple of years. Medal issue may have been approved by the advisory board but voted down by the Board of Control.
 - Doug -- Can we start the team meet on Friday earlier? It may help with the late night and back-to-back days.
 - Parking lot may be a problem on Friday with kids getting out of school.
 - Girls have 2 sessions, one at 2pm friday, one at 2pm saturday. Individual prelims is at the same time as team finals, and team final routines count for indi prelims.
 - Ryan will bring it up to his A.D. for future years.
- Bill -- If your legs dip on a front-uprise to L, do you get credit?
 - Frank -- The same angle rules apply as for a static L. If you legs dip below 45 degrees, Large deduction and no credit. Also if arms bend more than 45 degrees, may be large deduction and no credit. Same for Kip-L.
