Officials:

- Coaches- Please get involved and see if you can take one to help diffuse the number of meets others are taking for the remainder of season of for future years.
- We had several meets unfilled this season where coaches had to judge. It is not fair to them, nor does it look good to A.D.s if we can't find officials for meets.
- Officials renewal is May 1- June 30, and would be a good time for a new official to get registered for next season. Any questions contact someone on the exec board, or Blaise.
- Please be patient with new judges
- Please rate officials after each varsity meet- Stay current with this and your top 15 list
 - These ratings carry over for 3 years and carries into the following 2 seasons. Be sure to rate even during conference, sectional and state series. These ratings are used, including comments, to place judges at meets as well as on specific events.
- You May want to wait until the season is over to renew. A new concussion exam is being added and most of your tests will expire between now and August. If you renew during season you will have to renew again in 2 years during season when it is a busier time for you.

- Promote shadow judging on potential judges. Encourage assistants to leave practice early once
 per season to judge a meet and encourage them a few times a season to shadow a judge during
 one of their own meets. Create a flyer to pass out after meets to encourage parents and former
 athletes.
- Create a list of where coaches are coming from to make it easier to accommodate judging.

- Proposal to Open up entire week to sectional dates. Can be hosted Monday-Saturday -passed
- Proposal top ten places in state receive medals- passed
- Proposal submitted by Blaise Blasko
 - o Constitutional Amendment to Article III, Membership, A-4
 - A Full member must be present at two four Association meetings prior to the May meeting
 - Seconded by Alex
- Discussion:
 - Attempts to increase attendance at meetings
 - We struggle to get people to attend 2 meetings let alone 4, we don't want to punish and disincentivize
 - Past practice- Everyone is allowed to vote at the Winter clinic, those are the ballots that matter

- We can easily use previous year attendance to let only those eligible vote in December

- Discussion on how to get more coaches to meetings, why are people not able to come-travel, families, meets, etc. Perhaps a digital format could be adapted to allow for one virtual meeting attendance. Any other incentives or penalties for coming or not coming?
