- <u>Number of meets need to be filled....8</u> **SPOTS LEFT TO BE FILLED-** Thanks to those who stepped in, please continue to do so! Please click this link for remaining openings - there have been several meets where coaches have had to judge their own meets, please help alleviate this problem.
- Take advantage of shadowing opportunities for your own education or for the \$25 incentive

- Take, or make your own, flyer to advertise at your meets, or on twitter, to reach potential judges
- Officials will need to sign up for Arbiter Pay for state series. This is how the IHSA will pay officials now.
- Please be patient with new judges
- Please rate officials after each varsity meet- Stay current with this and your top 15 list
- Conference reps and coaches: Please make an effort at your post season conference meetings to ask that your schedules be spread out to alleviate issues of too many meets on one night. April 10 had several meets without judges due to so many duals taking place. Please consider condensing meets into Tri meets, having meets on other days during the week, having a meet the 3rd week of April or first of March, etc.

- If you're going to have a wave of new judges, it might not be the worst thing the world to give the judge a heads up if you have a gymnast doing an uncommon skill or get back to giving routines or start values Harima

Rules Proposals

- Due to the new Voting timeline, rules proposals were due before the March meeting. This month, discussion will take place on proposals.
 - Please see the Constitution excerpt for complete rule change details, The Constitution in total can be found on the IHSGCA website.
- In May- Voting will take place following the announcement of the proposal, one pro and one con; no further discussion is to be had. Full members must have attended two meetings before voting to be eligible to vote on association matters.

- Constitutional Amendment:
 - Proposal by Chad Jaros- Update the term of officers to be 2 years. Each year a new secretary and Vice President would be elected.
 - People might be more likely to volunteer for the positions of they're only 2 year stints
 - Con maybe nobody wants to be secretary or treasurer

• Rules Changes proposed by Doug Foerch:

- 1. Only one 'B' value or higher scissor.
 - We get rules from FIG or JO, and one thing that we maybe forget sometimes is they make rules off of what they see. For a long time a Handspring on Vault was close in value to a Tsuk
 - We need to maybe guard ourselves from coaches who will take advantage of the rules
 - If you watch any collegiate or international routine, it's an anomaly to see a gymnast do less than 1 B scissor
 - It's really difficult to get difficulty value without doing a couple of B scissors
- 2. Frosh PH-Keep moore and replace spindle with back moore.
 - Another idea to give something to vote for on mushroom
 - Back moores are hard on mushroom
- 3. HB- No bonus for the second skill if performing both a kip-cast-piro, and pirouette.
 - Eliminate doubling up on bonus for doing piro AND kip-cast-piro
 - Is it worth the rule just to take away .1 bonus for a single repeat skill
 - This kind of rule helps club kids more than high school
- 4. FX-May receive no more than two 'B' or higher skills from EG I.
 - Make it more beneficial for gymnasts who do tumbling
- \circ 5. SR-No bonus for 1/1 tw back somi.
 - Make a double back worth more than a 1/1 tw
- 6. SR-.Remove shoulder stands from non EG list and make it a .2 deduction.
 - Shoulder stands on varsity shouldn't be allowed
- 7. PB-front up rise needs to finish with hips bar height, regardless of following skill.
 - rescinded
- 8. V-have a minimum distance required for no deduction.
 - Kid hit his head on a vault and could have scored a 9.5 if the judge hadn't see it
 - It doesn't look right when someone lands too close

• Rules Proposal, by Eric Harima:

- \circ Modify the third bonus on freshman mushroom from a moore to back to two flairs.
 - Eric thinks flairs are cooler
 - Moores are hard on mushroom
- Rules Proposals, by Blaise Blasko:
 - Resolution 1: Starting time for all boys gymnastics meets on weekdays is 6:30.
 - Make it easier for coaches to get to meets after practice
 - Hagel would judge fewer meets if they went later into the night. Would prefer to leave practice early
 - Proposal 2: On Pommel horse, all FIG skills that end in front support without a circle or circling attempt afterwards will receive skill value but no element group or bonus credit.

- Rules Proposal, by Ryan Dul:
 - Proposal: To allow SB #5 on Freshmen Floor to be allowed following only one back handspring without having to perform SB #4. For example, a gymnast who competes Round-off - Back Handspring - Back Salto will still be able to receive SB #5 even though they did not compete SB #4. A gymnast who completes Round-off - Back Handspring -Back Handspring - Back Salto would receive both SB #4 and #5.
 - Very similar as to how SB#4 and SB#5 work on P-bars
 - No discussion

Informal Polls:

- Coaches- please indicate whether or not you think you'd like to see a shift to JV1 and JV2 instead of Frosh and JV to help alleviate the low freshman numbers some teams are experiencing.
 - Yes- look into shifting to JV1 and JV2
 - No- Keep it the same with our Frosh, JV and Varsity levels
 - It seemed most were not interested in the switch. There could be some issue with age and strength of older athletes competing with freshman unfairly. We could keep freshman level, and on the JV level perhaps allow some sort of hybrid in the future of compulsory and level 9, or let the athlete choose if they aren't close enough to a level 9 routine to be worth it. Something to consider pursuing further in the future.
