State of Gymnastics in IHSA

Message from Tracie

Overview

• IHSA is looking at Boys and Girls gymnastics because they are under the 10% threshold for school participant threshold

Propose this to 1000 athletes instead of 10%. We are currently at 1300 athletes.

Julian Balser was denied starting a boys program at Wheeling by their AD

New charter schools that join the IHSA count against us.

- Individual participants do count towards the threshold for the school they attend
- If sports are dropped, IHSA would no longer fund the State Series Sectionals and State
- IHSA voted to keep Boys and Girls gymnastics state series for 2020 at the meeting in September
- Financial Deficit for IHSA state series
 - \$12k for boys
 - \$28k for girls

Ideas & Suggestions

- Push back against the characterization that Boys Gymnastics is dwindling. Data shows consistent numbers of teams between 2004 and now. Email was sent, please share with your ADs (D. Foerch)
- Bring in gymnasts from CPS, and other schools without teams as individual participants. Individual participants count as a school for IHSA 10% threshold (Costa, Batista, Mukai)
 - Work up a run-sheet for sponsors to follow (Mukai, Batista has a bunch of info)
 - Maine schools and others may have individuals. (Batista)
- Bring in some club boys for state series; Gymkana (Mukai)
- Break up Co-ops. Is there a way we can affect this? (Costa)
 - Wheaton
 - Maine schools individuals?
- Move to a Co-Ed sport (Blasko)
- Move to a fall sport so that it doesn't conflict with USAG (Batista, Cordts)
- Have IHSGCA cover the financial deficit. Maybe find a corporate sponsor (Hagel)
- If IHSA drops the programs, could we join USAG at the region 5 state meet? (Costa)
- Coordinate with the Girls Association (Novakowski)
 - Chad emailed and texted Girls President
 - Judy is interested in coordinating.
 - We have not been invited to join in their clinic on October 25th.
- Meet with Tracie
 - She'll be in town for the girls clinic on Friday, October 25th. She agreed to meet with us. Need to coordinate a time
- Charley Nelson has a contact within USAG who may craft a letter to IHSA ADs

Steering Committee Actions

- IHSA Board of Directors proposal to change cancellation rule to 1000 participants

- Send invitation to Girls Association to coordinate actions
- IHSA Advisory Board proposal Change State Meet to 2 sessions
 - Expect to see proposal at the December clinic

Each session costs about 3k. We would save about 4-5k.

Possibly go to 4 sectionals instead of 5.

This would get proposed in April and voted on in June.

- Increase attendance / ticket sales at State Series
 - Collaborate with Girls Gymnastics to attend each others meets
 - 60th IHSGCA Anniversary HOF and Alumni gathering
