Sectional Packet Collected

- New membership was updated (still need some additional information from certain members). New total Membership is 76!!!
- Votes from all the sectionals were counted for senior gymnast and H.O.F.
- National Registration forms for the National High School Gymnastic Coaches Association were also collected (All members of the IHSGCA are encouraged to join). The IHSGCA will pay national dues for all members who filled out a national registration form (This will give you voting rights in the NHSGCA election).

HOF Problems

- In the 2005 HOF committee election, a member of the association was voted in without being asked or notified. As a result this member (understandable) declined the position. This leaves an opening in the committee that needs to be filled. Greg Gebhardt suggested that the HOF committee select a six member that is qualified to fill the position.
- Other suggestions were made by members to change the HOF committee
 - O Vic Avigliano suggested that a chairman position should be created in the committee that has a four year office to maintain continuity.
 - o Scott Hagel suggested that committee be reduced to five members to reduce ties.

Amendment to Article IX (Rule Changes)

 Pro and Con statements were made about the amendment proposed and discussed last week. • The Pro statement was that the rule changes would now be voted on at our December meeting, which is our largest. It also creates a closer relationship with our association and the IHSA advisory board.

Rule Changes

- Pro and Con Statements were made about each rule
 - **1.** Count four scores for team totals

Con: Vic Avigliano: it might hurt smaller programs

Pro: Mark Wanner: it prevents three man teams from dominating and promotes the development of fourth and fifth scores.

2. Five competitors per event, no all-around requirement

Con: No Con was offered

Pro: Bill Cordts: It allows an extra competitor if you don't have an all arounder

3. Six competitors per event

Con: Bill Cordts it might hurt lower level participation

Pro: Sam Zeman it would give more opportunities for competition.

4. Allow 9.0 or higher vault on freshman level

Pro: With the table vaulting is much safer.

Con: None

5. Eliminate two fall limit on freshman level

Pro: Eric Liva: It already happens a lot anyway

Con: None
