1) Jason Orna

Proposal: Since we are coming up on a new quadrennium, I would like to have a committee evaluate and redesign our Frosh Compulsories.

Reasoning: Many coaches are critical of compulsories; however, many find them necessary. The flow of these routines are poor and are now 5 years out of date, and no longer in congruence with the level 5 USAG compulsory routines.

Q: Is this asking for a separate committee to look at the routines or?

A: Frank, speaking for Jason, mentions that Jason was originally unaware that this was part of the Rules Committee's already established duties

Q: Does this mean just the extra bonus skills? Are we sticking to the level 5 compulsory? A:Level 5 has been modified since the routines inception, and while we have so far kept the routines the same, they will be re-evaluated and modified by the Rules Committee
