Rule Proposals

Rule Proposals Procedural Update

Considering the impact of the new code coming out this year, it is best that rule proposals are collected by the Executive board and proposed to the Association in March. A discussion will be held in the April meeting so that potential proposals can be heard and rationale be given, ~~but there will be no vote on them in May.~~ There will be a non-binding vote in May on rule proposals which will help the Rules Committee be able to better gauge where the Association stands in regards to the proposed rules. The proposals and voting results will then be submitted to the rules committee and while the new code is analyzed and worked through by the rules committee, they will simultaneously be examining and considering the proposals and votes originating from the association.

Clarification - voting on other proposals that DO NOT deal with new rules or the new rule book (Constitutional Amendments for example) will still have true voting protocol.

For the good of the Association/New Business:

Advisory Board Meeting Update:

- The advisory board would like us to consider the number of teams allowed at the state meet. More importantly the rationale.
- The two reps for the girls' judges seemed to be against expanding the number of teams given that the Friday session is already long, the addition of another team would increase the time to 4+ hours.
- For the boys, the steering committee discussion was that the expanding the number of teams for the boys' meet would not be difficult to do, and could be incorporated relatively easily.
- Girls also wanted to expand the awards from 5 to 10 individual medals. The objection was that there were not enough participants in the sport in general to be giving out 10 individual awards per event. Other sports have larger numbers of athletes.
 - Terms and conditions changes proposed to advisory board need to be proposed by the January meeting
- Tracie would like us to make a Sectional/State suggested mat list. This is so the host schools will have adequate matting available for all the participants.
 - Matting was a checklist not a hard requirement so that each of the Sectional schools will know what is needed to host a meet with all necessary matting.

- Coaches take a mental note at this years' sectional meets.
 - Potential Future to-do list: create a standardized list of mats that should be had by schools that host Sectionals.
- Tracie said she was happy with the number of judges for sectionals. Also the number of teams increased from 46-51.

Other: Greg Gebhardt needs some judges this week. (see above - Pg. 3 in the minutes)

- Didech spoke with some Texas HS coaches that want to get the Sr national meet back in action. This has been a major goal of the fundraising the Steering committee has been encouraging.
- Harrison Bull Freshman invite has been canceled. Not enough teams invited to the meet have freshman teams available to compete. Focusing on their JV teams.
- From the perspective of an AD, when a meet or invite is scheduled, that is a contractual obligation. One AD must call the other AD to cancel the contract, not a coach calling another coach telling them they cannot make the meet/cancel the contract.
