Updates

IHSA:

- Recently contacted Tracie Henry again about having our representatives attend a meeting with the Board of Directors
 - She said, "I have communicated to our Executive Director that Boys Gymnastics would like to be a part of one of the upcoming Board Agenda's. I will follow up with him."
- This June, when the decision has to be made on Boys Gymnastics for the 2024 season, will there be a review and vote (as in the past seasons) or will this be an objective decision based solely on 2023 team numbers?
 - Tracie's response, "No, I do not think the language requires a vote. However, I can ask our Executive Director for clarification"

DFoerch- They do not call it a vote, they "decide" on it. Their decision will be based on the board members. New Trier AD said the decision should be a lot sooner than June.

Traci said they are NOT meeting before June.

There will be contract issues with school districts.

Gymnastic Clubs: We need this to be done

- Gymnastics Club Call Google Sheet (THIS IS A LIVE DOCUMENT)
 - Gymnastics Clubs
 - We need volunteers to look through the list and start making calls.
 - What should you say when calling
 - Prompt for club gym calls

Teams must be filed and done by Feb 1st.

We want to push clubs teams to have three competing individuals, but if it is only one or two gymnasts, we want to encourage it.

Blaise- two ways to compete in the IHSA meet- individual or a team. If you want to compete as a team, you must have 6 DATES on the schedule to be seen as a team.

Keith Mukai- The IHSA will focus on the list of competitors, not the scores.

Ryan Dul - Why would an AD consider a team or not? Blaise - No financial difference, ethics would be the only issue (need 6 competition dates, an school rep and a coach)

Co-ops- can they be split?

Some schools have pushed back on creating a team. Parent involvement is huge to push AD's to create a team.

Schools:

- Batavia High School
 - o A parent reached out expressing interest in having her son compete and form a team
 - AD was willing to have him compete individually, but not form a team
 - o I contacted AD with how to go about starting a team and offered assistance
 - His reply, "Thanks for reaching out. We will not be starting a boys gymnastics team at Batavia High School. We've sent out surveys annually for interest in any sport that we don't currently offer. We have no data or finances that would support a new team."
 - I contacted the parent again and asked if she could get data that supports the want for a team at Batavia High School.
