State of Gymnastics

Updates

IHSA Board of Directors Meeting-

- Tony Medina, Palatine HS Principal-
 - emphasized the impact that gymnastics provides for under-represented students
 - Many gymnasts wouldn't be involved in anything else
 - Majority have not competed in gymnastics prior to high school
 - For parents, coming to an event like a Senior Night, this is the only time that they come in to the school
 - Strong tradition at PHS that needs to continue, it is too valuable to the kids and culture
- John Catalano, Glenbrook North AD-
 - Also spoke on the importance that gymnastics has for the kids
 - Also, many have not competed prior to high school
 - Why the change in policy, is it financial, gym space, participation?
 - If it is financial, work with the association about reducing costs
 - If it is gym space, know that it will be 2 sports that you are affecting (boys and girls).
 - Negative publicity
 - This decision will not look good for the IHSA
 - If schools and districts decide not to have the sport, let them make that decision, not the IHSA.
 - Asked for an additional 3 years of support after this season to allow for growth
 - Thought this is a fair number
- Frank
 - Our association has been trying to grow, but ran into some unforeseen circumstances
 - Working to re-engage CPS
- Jason
 - o Our sport was hit particularly hard from Covid, but we are already showing growth again
 - This growth shows that there is a want and need for gymnastics
 - We need IHSA support to continue this growth

• Craig Anderson, IHSA Executive Director- IHSA will make a decision in June

MSL HC meeting-

- If IHSA does not support, then Superintendents would meet this summer to make their own decision on MSL moving forward
- District 214 schools are already reaching out to local gymnastics clubs for outsourcing gym space
- Barrington High School
 - does not have any talks about building a gymnastics gym
 - Boys/girls will be going to Kiaga
 - Gym at Barrington High School will be revisited if numbers start to drop
 - They are keeping their equipment though (so apparently they have space to store all of it, who knows)
