CJ Johnson- What does the IHSA have to gain from this? Why can't they look at this logistically? Jesse White wants to help, but is not sure quite how to go about doing so?

Doug- The Boards Policy will not change. We need to ask to be allowed to keep us.

Blaise- Why did they change the percentage?

Julian- Can we ask Tracie, "What does the IHSA have to gain?"

Eric Harima- This has to do with emerging sports.

Mike Costa- How is this equitable? How is this not financial?

Tracie Henry- Not making this decision. There needs to be differentiation between adding and deleting sports. When you see a decline in participation numbers... She is trying to advocate, but cannot make any changes. Asking the board for an extended time with Boys Gymnastics, allowing for coaches, facilities,

CJ Johnson- Are they looking at state-wide numbers? Or focusing north of I-80?

TH- No, the geography of the state isn't part of participation.

Blaise-Do club sports follow the same rules/protocols as IHSA sports?

TH-No. Each school might be slightly different.

Blaise- Does the IHSA Affirmative Action Policy come into play?

TH- How do you think that impacts boys?

Blaise- Boys might look to compete in girls gymnastics.

TH- page 112- No, a member will not be able to join.

Julian- what about girls previously boys.

TH- That goes back to the underrepresented gender.

Eric Harima- Would girls have more sports than boys if boys gymnastics does get dropped? Would boys then be underrepresented?

TH- No, the policy is for the underrepresented gender.

Ryan Brown- What about the adults? This is part of our time and income? When would they let us know so that we can put our energy into the boys and our sport? Have they thought about the kids that do not have the money to join a gym?

TH- Many are asking for a better timeline for all of those that are affected by this decision. Have an AD or Principal ask at our meeting. It doesn't mean that your school wouldn't have a team.

Sam- We are rebounding after COVID, doesn't that make a difference. Reviewing on an annual basis hurts us too.

TH- Try to meet the thresholds.

Mike Costa- What about looking at the students as students, not "numbers".

TH-Has not heard that, wants to clear the air.
