

## **Rules Proposal Pro/Con**

- Move to Fall Survey Findings/Data
  - 15 responses (10 head coaches)

15 responses

- Of the 10 responses, by head coaches, 1 responded that they would lose someone on staff
- Of the 12 responding programs reporting on loss of gymnasts
  - 6 programs would have no loss
  - 3 programs would lose 1-2 gymnasts
  - 1 program would lose 3-4 gymnasts
  - 2 programs would lose 5+ gymnasts
- Of the 12 responding programs reporting on the addition of gymnasts
  - 4 programs would have no gain
  - 5 programs would gain 1-2 gymnasts
  - 1 program would gain 3-4 gymnasts
  - 2 programs would gain 5+ gymnasts
- o 6 programs would gain club gymnasts, 6 would not
- Only 2 programs responded that they do not currently have a way to recruit incoming freshmen
- Keith Mukai's Freshman Pommel Horse revision proposal
  - Motion Keith Mukai, Second- CJ Patton. Motion Passes to have timed discussion
    - Discussion 5 minute only
      - KM- frosh still unsuccessful on mushroom, CJ Patton- agrees with Mukai
      - Blaise/Greg Moved to the rules committee, it is a good developmental skill for freshman.
      - Dfoerch has the mushroom improved or hurt...and has not improved. S Philips agrees that it is not effective as the horse.
      - B.Blasko- more issues not gained from the mushroom.

- CJ- great training tool but not as effective as what club does. We do not have the time to get the benefits of the mushroom unlike USAG (two years versus 3 months)
