If your school is okay with you not being registered and is fine with you competing, we won't argue, but my official stance is **register**. The more numbers we have, the longer we stay in conversation

Score would be communicated to the coach/athlete, but not marked within MeetScorer. The exhibition athletes will not exceed the five competing athletes for a team. (Second: Frank N.)

- To register for an AAU membership, click here: <u>AAU Membership</u> You will be registering for a Non-Athlete Membership, Extended Benefit Membership (AB). The cost for the extended benefit membership is \$57 for 1 year, or \$79 for 2 years, and is only an additional \$2 over the standard membership. Your membership will provide a background check for everyone, which ADs feel is an important part of the process. I did not receive an email when the process was completed, but I was able to log into my account after about a week and verify that the process was complete.
