At the conclusion of this Spring season, we will aim to move to the Fall of 2025.

Week 11: October 20-25 - SECTIONALS

Week 12: October 27 - November 1 - STATE MEET

NO HOST

- Better gymnastics
 - o More time to train during Summer camps (9 weeks of practice before first meet as opposed to the current 3 weeks) this would roll directly into the start of School and the Season on August 11.
 - o Increase number of possible club gymnast to join because of no conflicts with Club meets or National team
 - o No conflict with Boys Wrestling extending into the start of season
- Less conflicts
 - o No scheduling problems for differences in spring breaks, the only indoor sport is girls volleyball
 - o Less academic issues with athletes at the beginning of the school year
 - o Fewer Fall sports than spring sports
- Increase Participation and draw attention to our sport in the fall
 - o Gymnasts can perform in school pep assemblies at your school to gain attention in the fall.
 - o More Cheerleaders would be willing to compete and get better at tumbling with quality instruction from coaches.
- Strong support from the clubs to move the sport to the Fall
- Coaches and athletes would get their Spring Break back
- 12 week season meaning it would cost less to keep Gymnastics around
- There would be a week buffer between Boys Season and Girls season
- This makes logical sense
- Ensures us one more season

PROPOSED FALL 2025 Calendar with MEETS

- Notes:
 - Potentially reaching out to Park Districts to have your team summer camp listed in the summer activities program. Currently how Glenbards run summer camp.
 - Cheer did not move to fall
 - Christian:
 - Moving to spring itself could be the killing factor
 - Club athletes will not want to go (not many will want to go)
 - We do not know the support of our new Superintendent
 - o CJ:
- LP AD also said Fall 25/26
- Do not believe it would kill
- First fall season will be rough and through time can have a positive relationship and will improve
- Won't be as bad with the different clubs
- Ryan:
 - Struggle to recruit Freshmen during beginning of season
 - Easier to recruit later in school year because they are more comfortable in high school
 - Especially when season starts before school year starts
 - Stipend issues when lowered from 13 to 12 week season
 - Created an entire fall season to give to CSL ADs and were all onboard
 - Steering committee needs to make this happen ASAP
- Alex:
 - What has this sport become?
 - Increase quality of sport because summer camps immediately to fall
 - Pulls more kids in the fall than battling out with more sports in the spring
 - Cons of moving to fall may not outway the push in moving it
 - Central and South dropping

- Approach as if we are moving to the fall and if it does not work this year and then make it work for the next
- Adrian:
 - ADs are looking just for enough numbers
 - We need a confirmation on either a yes or no from every AD for moving to fall
 - Need to pressure ADs for an answer
 - Opinion: Cannot go under 25 teams
- Carlos:
 - Getting more sophomores and juniors because demographics we have now are different and freshmen are getting cherry picked early
 - Getting middle schools for an open gym practice
- Sam:
 - Took a big hit because of not having gymnastics in the PE curriculum.
- O Howie:
 - How many schools have in-district coaches?
 - How many schools have summer programs?
 - Motion: Reach out to IHSGGCA to work together if both drop and have both seasons in the winter as a new emerging sport called coed gymnastics. This is just a contingency plan.
 - Seconded: Frank
 - Yay = 13
 - Nay = 6

 - Divers join
- Bill Cordts:
 - AD hinted that this season may be it
- Jason Brandenburg:
 - Absolute check that every school has talk to their AD with our proposal schedule
- We would lose coaches:
 - Hinsdale South: Head
 - Superintendent would make it a co-op or remove both schools if moved to the fall
 - Central is staying because South school has it
 - Not a lot of support from administration
 - WSC Conference dissolved if this happens
 - Palatine: Freshmen
- Steering committee needs to create a draft to send out now
- Reach out to previous judges

 - Make sure to remind your AD that the sectional meet is run as an invite, a contract should be sent out and a fee should be paid by the schools that attend. What is that entry fee? The host school should be charging a fee (\$250) for the sectional.
 - Frank asked for entry fee on wrestling invites \$425 for LP last two invites.
 - Worth considering recommending a higher fee for entry to sectionals and state meets.

<u>Judging</u>

Requirements:

- 1. <u>AAU membership</u> To register for an AAU membership, click here: <u>AAU Membership</u> You will be registering for a Non-Athlete Membership, Extended Benefit Membership (AB). The cost for the extended benefit membership is \$57 for 1 year, or \$79 for 2 years, and is only an additional \$2 over the standard membership. Your membership will provide a <u>background check</u>.
- 2. NFHS Concussion education To complete the free concussion training, click here: NFHS Concussion in Sports Select your state from the dropdown menu, and then click Order Course. The course is free, and you will be provided a certificate upon completion.
- 3. <u>Bi-Annual Clinic Attendance</u> Judging Clinic February 8th @ Lake Park
- On a side note, the Steering Committee is looking at creating a mandatory exam, and exploring the making of a rules video similar to the one we have had in previous years.

System for Rating Officials

The two-person Judging Selection committee will consist of the Chairman who will lead the Committee on selecting Judges for the Sectional and State meet, and the Assistant Chair who will assist in the selection of

Judges. Last year, these roles were filled by Doug Foerch and Blaise Blasko. Doug has respectfully asked to be replaced this year as he will be out of town during the week of the Conference Championships. Names of nominees will be accepted at this meeting.

The responsibilities of the Rating System Executives

- A. These executives will collect coaches' feedback on officials throughout the season
- B. They will use these rankings to determine judge selection for the Sectionals and State Meets
- C. They will be responsible for assigning each judge to a specific event
- D. The Chairman will assign a State Meet Official to help with inquiries
- E. The Chairman will communicate frequently with both the IHSGCA Executive Board and the State Meet Host School

The Criteria for Officials' Ratings

As it stands, from the IHSA page - for each meet the following questions are answered:

- Name/ event judged
- Date of Contest
- Did the officials call affect the outcome of the match
- Rating 1-5 (1 being excellent)
- Reason for unsatisfactory rating
