- What Are The Goals of the Sponsorship Committee?
 - Responsibilities will include: Creation of sponsorship levels for different donation amounts -For Example:



- \$200 donation Business will have their Company Logo printed within our State program,
- \$500 business will have their logo printed in program and featured in an announcement at the meet as a Sponsor of the State Meet.
- \$1,000 Company logo will be featured on the inside cover and back page of the program,

State of Gymnastics

Move to Fall 2025 - At the conclusion of this Spring season, we aim to move to the Fall of 2025.

Where do we currently stand?

- It's in discussion and we are gathering information and data from AD's and Coaches
- Letter to ADs here
- What ADs want to hear participation increases are by far the most important goal
 - The problem? Nobody knows whether having the season in the fall will positively or negatively affect individual team participation. Until we gain more information, all we have is speculation. What we do know is that a few programs will likely be dropped.
 Makes a compelling case to consider all avenues and gain as much information as we can before deciding to move
 - In conclusion, we have the idea in front of the ADs and are actually getting answers now. While it may not happen in 2025, The tangible knowledge we are getting into what moving will look like in the future, whether it is possible, and the direction we go in from here, is valuable to our organization and the future of the sport.

Next Steps:

- It is recommended that we schedule a statewide call with all the ADs that have a boys program to gain some insight from ADs into what the move would actually look like and get everyone on the same page. Could be easier to schedule a call based on Conference.
 - Looking for an AD that would be willing to sponsor this call. I am starting with the WSC gymnastics sport sponsor and the Conference AD President.
 - It could be helpful to have coaches on the call as well.
- Speaking with our Coaches and getting feedback on the details and struggles of what actually moving may involve on an individual school-by-school basis.

- (John Catalano) Glenbrook North AD Potential volunteer to be representative to schedule a state wide AD call.
- 211 ADs very concerned about finding State Host as well as making decision based on lack of clear information from single entity
- 6 out of 9 ADs in WSC (ADs present) voted against moving to the fall
- Steve Kafka Would they continue the program if schools did not move to the fall?
 - Likely at
- Interesting to look at how many freshmen are available in the fall considering the multiple different freshmen teams between the two seasons.
- (Joe Kain) Glenbard West AD Suggested participation would be higher in the spring. "This move has to benefit all programs"
 - After the meeting, I (AP) examined the rosters of Freshman Boys Sports at 3 Schools - Glenbard West, Niles West, And Downers North. I did not include Gymnastics in the totals, as they are the control group we are discussing. I also did not see if there was any crossover of athletes that played a fall sport which might conflict with Gymnastics were it to move to the fall. This was simply a raw count of Freshman participation.

- Glenbard West Fall Roster totals: 122, Spring Totals: 115
- Niles West Fall: 111, Spring: 78
- Downers Grove North Fall: 123, Spring: 93
 - Until further data is collected to refute the findings of this
 relatively small sample, it would appear that though there are
 fewer number of sports in the fall, there are not actually more
 "available" athletes that could potentially find a home on the
 gymnastics roster. The idea of having fewer sports in the fall
 leading to an increase in participation is put in doubt.
- I would highly encourage other coaches to do the same experiment. Examine Freshman Rosters for fall and spring sports. Collect some actual data to support or refute the idea that if we do move to the fall, more athletes would come out for the sport.
- Also, after examining the IHSA participation survey, it further supports the findings
 that existing roster numbers are higher in the fall sports than in the spring sports.

- ALex Pajor What is the deadline to schedule this to happen?

- Andy Issacason Goal to have 30+ on team this season and goal for everyone else too for the future
 - Even allowing kids to participate more than one sport during season
- Tony WSC ADs need more time to understand how this change impacts athletes
- Independent Conference suggests this conversation for 2026
- CJ Patton AD call is paramount regardless when this change happens and should be done this year.
 - 2026 is more reasonable and taking a more aggressive stance created a noticeable response

Rulebook 2025-2028

Clarifications:

- Rule 2.II.C.1.a The word "dismounts" has been changed to the word "skills".
 - On Floor Exercise <u>All multiple (more than one)</u> flipping and/or twisting <u>skills</u> will receive
 0.1 bonus if performed without a single large deduction on Floor Exercise
 - This was the original intent of the additional bonus.
- "Pillow mats" will not be acceptable for use in competition.

Judging

Requirements:

- 1. <u>AAU membership</u> To register for an AAU membership, click here: <u>AAU Membership</u> You will be registering for a Non-Athlete Membership, Extended Benefit Membership (AB). The cost for the extended benefit membership is \$57 for 1 year, or \$79 for 2 years, and is only an additional \$2 over the standard membership. Your membership will provide a <u>background check</u>.
- 2. NFHS Concussion education To complete the free concussion training, click here: NFHS Concussion in Sports Select your state from the dropdown menu, and then click Order Course. The course is free, and you will be provided a certificate upon completion.
- 3. Bi-Annual Clinic Attendance Judging Clinic February 8th @ Lake Park
- 4. <u>Mandatory Exam</u> The Steering Committee + Head Clinician will release a mandatory exam for all judges to take on an annual basis.
 - Steering Committee will look at estimated cost of making a rules video that can be updated each year

Rating System Executive Committee

Frank Novakowski will head the Committee in Doug Foerch's absence (Doug will assume his position in the following season). Blaise Blasko will retain his position as the Assistant Chair for this Committee.

New Rating System Format: (As Voted on and passed last year)

In the closing weeks of the regular season, head coaches will be provided a list of all registered officials who were assigned to at least three meets during the season. *Head coaches will be asked to select their top 15 officials from the list via an online survey.*

Coaches will not need to rank their selections. An official's "score" simply consists of how many coaches included that official in their Top 15 list.

Coaches will make their selections via an online survey that they will receive via email. All head coaches will be asked to participate. They do not need to be IHSGCA members. Conference Reps will be asked to ensure that as many head coaches respond as possible.

Coaches will have one week to make their selections once they receive the online survey.

The online survey will be due 10 days before the first Sectional to allow time for the results to be reviewed and the Sectionals assignments to be finalized.

The Steering Committee will prepare the online survey.

The Rating System Executives will review the coaches' selections and make their best effort to assign the officials receiving the most points to the Sectional and State meets. As in previous years, these assignments will take into account the officials' availability, strengths on each event, available pairings, as well as attempt to maintain consistency across Sectional meets.

Steering Committee will also recommend that the Executives give a certain number of points to judges for attending the Clinic, and a variable number of points based on exam score.
