- Ryan Brown: "Current gymnasts will be allowed to enter with their team for free. That's for the state meet."
- If the goal is to be consistent across all 3 sectionals, then we should all agree to charge the same fee for guest teams. That, however, is not what is currently happening, and there's not much the Association can do to prevent the host from contracting any fee or no fee. Same is true at the door. If the host school chooses not to charge spectators, or to charge spectators, then we have no say in what happens there.


CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT PROPOSAL (to be voted on today)

- Constitutional Amendment regarding the HOF voting cycle and the creation of reserve funds
 (2/3s majority of voting members of association needed to pass constitutional amendment)
 - E HOF Article XIII Amendment
 - Key Points:
 - Money, matching the cost of the HOF banquet from the preceding year, is put aside every year for 3 years (beginning this year) to cover the cost of 3 years of HOF Banquet in the case that the IHSGCA ceases to operate
 - That reserve will be looked after by the HOF committee to ensure that the HOF ceremonies continue for 3 years. And if the Association ceases to operate, will donate all remaining funds according to the philanthropy code in the constitution.
 - HOF inductees will have the choice to be inducted in the same year they were voted in or opt for the following year.
 - O 1 Pro:
 - Allowing inductees to be inducted the same year they are voted in. (Flexibility)
 - o 1 Con:
 - Requires us to put away funding in reserve that may need to be used elsewhere.

- Voting will be done through google form tonight or tomorrow morning.
- Voting took place electronically through a google form.
- Ballot was sent to ALL ELIGIBLE MEMBERS. (Full Members, whose dues were paid and who had attended at least 2 virtual + 1 in person, 3 virtual, or 2 in-person meetings between September and April, and Hall of Fame Members (no dues) who had attended at least 2 virtual + 1 in person, 3 virtual, or 2 in-person meetings.
- Voters were given 24 hours to submit their vote. Ballot was emailed at 9:00pm on May 1 with voting closing at 9:00pm on May 2.
- The Amendment passes, 19-2, with over ¾ majority voting in favor.
 - Funds will be moved to a separate savings account matching the total cost of the previous years HOF banquet at the following Steering Committee Meeting May 12, 2025.
 - Inductees (voting will take place at Sectionals) can choose to have their HOF ceremony this year or the following year.

Open Coaching Positions

Head Coach Positions: 2026

- **HINSDALE CENTRAL** Will be looking for a new coach as CJ Johnson will be retiring. Open teaching position as well, though not sure what subject. Reach out to CJ Johnson or Neil Krupika for more information.
- <u>Hoffman Estates High School</u> as Ryan Brown will be stepping away from coaching. Also means it may be time to look for a **new State meet site**.
- Hoffman Estates will also be looking for a Girls Team head coach

Assistant Coach Positions:

 Hoffman Estates - Dave Calish will be retiring. Also, may further indicate our need for a new State Meet site as Dave was also the State Finals Meet director.

For the good of the Membership/New Business:

- Regular Season Judging Assignments for 2026 could potentially operate under one assignment chair in order to avoid scheduling conflicts, and better help organize our judging assignments for future seasons. There are only about 24-27 teams and much easier to manage under one meet assigner.
 - Might get to a point where we have to fund parts of our program. Previously officials paid through Nisoc traditionally, would this be affected if we have to start funding an assigner?
 - ADs like just "pushing the button" on Arbiter. It is much easier.
 - o Ryan Brown Interested in the position if Bob or Greg do not want to do it.
 - Greg Gebhardt, being one of the current assigners, is interested in maintaining his role as the assigner and would likely be the recommended choice. Though discussion should occur, and, if other nominees are brought forward, a vote should be conducted. This would not conclude the matter as most Conferences need to interview the assigner candidate. However the vote on the assigner would allow us to make a recommendation to the Conferences about who our single assigner would be.
 - Motion (Keith Mukai Seconded by Adrian Batista): Motion that we vote that the association recommends that conferences coalesce to a single assigner.

Yay: 14Nay: 0Abstain: 1

- Though this vote gives an idea of where the Association stands, it was requested that Members be given more time to consider this decision and gather more information on whether condensing to 1 assigner would be viewed by AD's and Athletic Departments favorably. In the case that AD's are in favor, or have no opinion that this would bring negative attention to the sport, we would provide them with a recommended candidate.
- Right To Play Act (IL House Bill 3037) Allows athletes to play both club and high school at the same time
 - However this has also been done for years. Club gymnasts have competed at the same time as high school. However, athletes could not compete at the national and the state series at the same time (they had to choose).
 - The IHSA does not like this bill because it weakens some of their "power" to approve or deny Club-to-HS crossovers.
 - Coaches should look at the BIII 3037 and, as it may positively affect our, and other sports. They should make their voices heard by calling their State Rep.
