RESOLUTION PROPOSAL:

• **Title:** Requirement to Enter State Series

o Timeline: 2026-2046

- Resolution Proposal: All represented schools are required to compete in a minimum of two (2) competitions during the regular season in order to be eligible for the State series.
- Reasoning: Under IHSA, previous rules stipulated a minimum of six (6) contests in order to participate in State series. Shortening the number of contents to two (2) acknowledges the lower number of schools with high school boys gymnastics by increasing the opportunity of more school representation within the State series. This resolution will make competing in Illinois High School Boys Gymnastics easier for new schools while still assisting in increasing the number of schools. The eligibility requirement will also bring a fair process for all current and new member schools, giving the same opportunity to all individuals and team competitors.
- Proposed at May Meeting, Discussed at November Meeting, 1 pro- con- and vote in December meeting
- This would go in our IHSGCA State Handbook if passed
- Now we have a better idea of how the State Series runs and have a more democratic process in creating a process for the State Meet.

- RULES PROPOSAL- Author: Joon Yun -
 - Can this be voted on at Winter Clinic for the upcoming year?
 - The number of minimum skills will change from 6 to 8 skills (no repetition allowed). The scoring format will remain the same (2.2 diff, 2.0 EG, 5.8 execution), but instead of 1 point deduction from the executions for each missing skill, gymnasts will get 0.5 deductions each for the first two skills missing and then 1 point off for each missing skill thereafter.
 - Example: If a gymnast has all of the element groups, +1.0 in difficulty, and has 7 skills, the maximum score would be (5.8 0.5'' + 2.0 + 1.0) = 8.3
 - o If a gymnast has all of the element groups, +1.0 in difficulty, and has 5 skills, the maximum score would be (5.8 "2.0" + 2.0 + 1.0) = 6.8 With our current scoring system, this routine would have a maximum value of 7.8
 - Given how many non-diagram A skills we allow, this rule change will encourage gymnasts to pursue a wide variety of skills and coaches to create more diverse routines.
 - Motion (Blase): Table until March 2026 meeting (Seconded: Frank)
 - Would not be taken into effect until the 2027 season if passed
